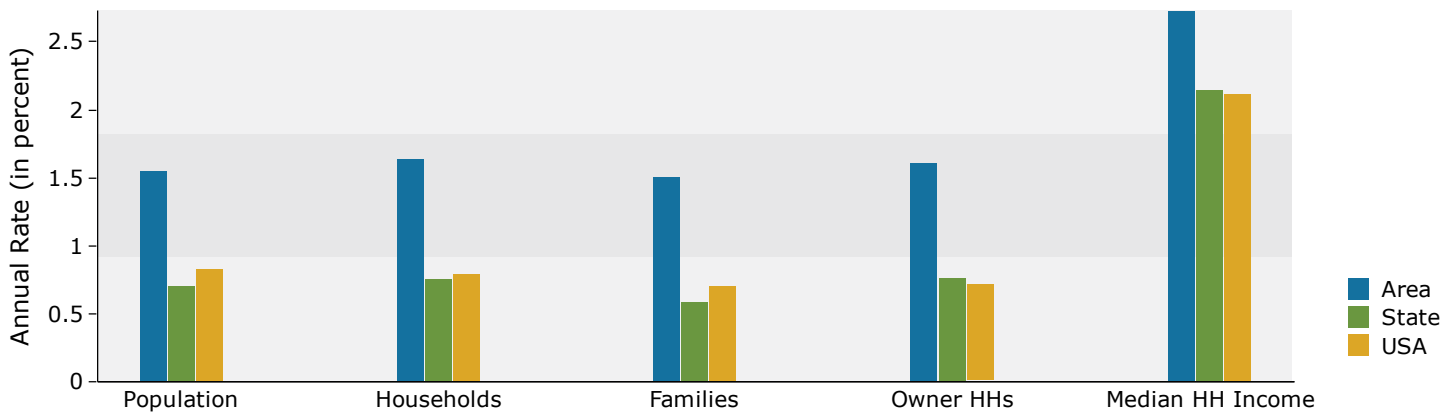

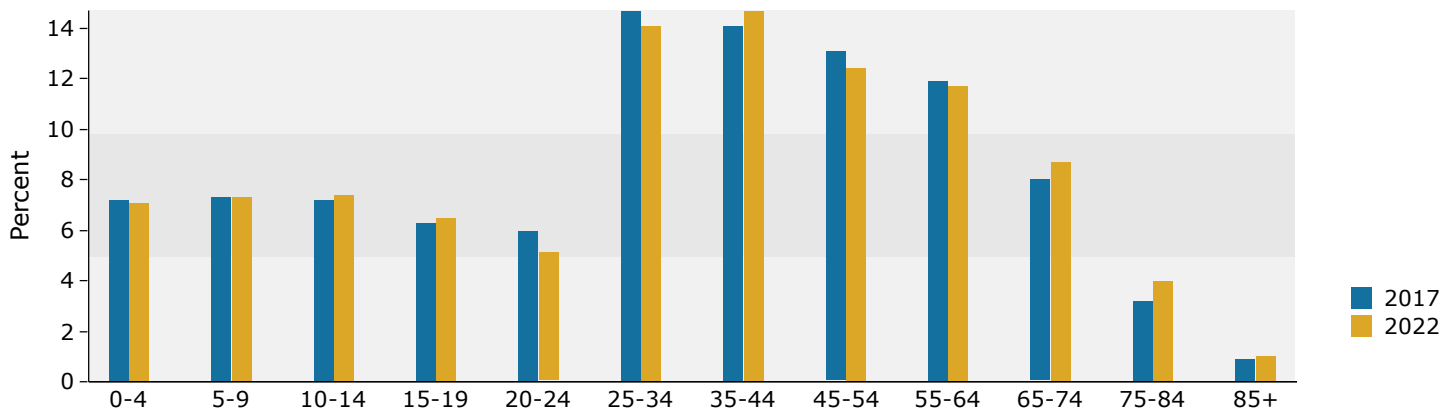

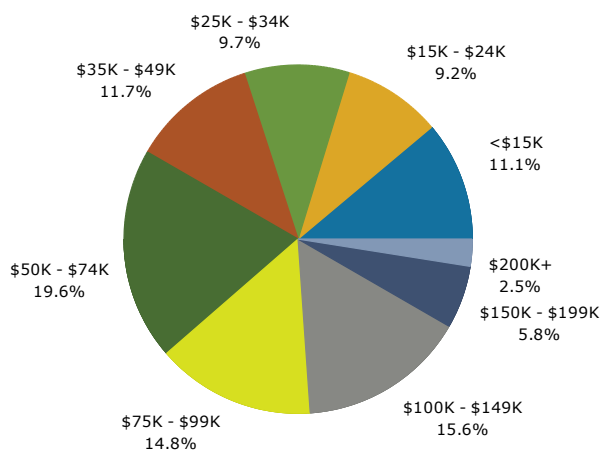
## Trends 2017-2022



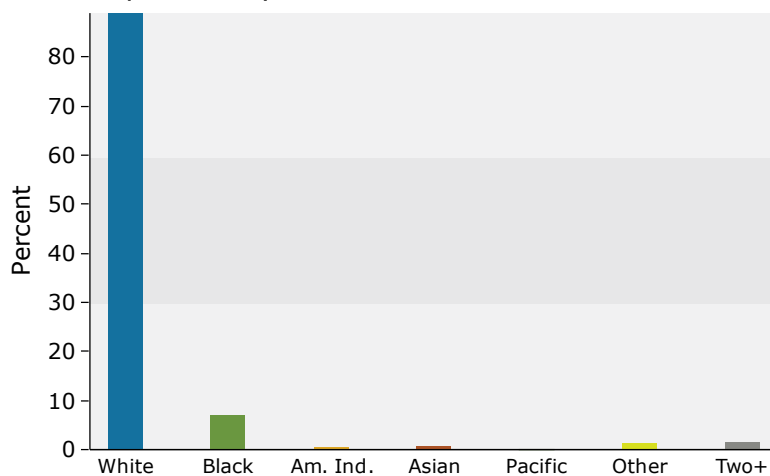
## Population by Age
