- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 11.3% in Livingston Parish, LA from 34,108 to 37,966. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 7.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 63.3% to 62.3% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **16.3% of Livingston Parish, LA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.9% below the national average), and **7.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Warehouse Clubs, Supercenters, and Other General Merchandise Retailers.




Jun 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity





Population Trends



Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Livingston Parish, LA had a June 2024 unemployment rate of 3.63%, decreasing from 3.94% 5 years before.




Livingston Parish, LA has 31,441 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 30,180.




Veterans

Livingston Parish, LA has 8,203 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 7,763.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Livingston Parish, LA. The national average for an area this size is 44,480 people 55 or older, while there are 38,152 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Livingston Parish, LA. The national average for an area this size is 61,038 racially diverse people, while there are 24,905 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries





Top Industry Employment Concentration












Top Occupation Employment Concentration


Top Occupation Earnings








